English

We will base our learning around the texts: 'Tales from Outer Suburbia' by S. Tan, Persuasive Texts and Narrative poems by Lewis Carroll and Hilaire Belloc.

Skills: In our narrative topic, writing a short fantasy story. In the Persuasive Texts topic, designing and writing a persuasive print advert. In the poetry topic, writing a narrative poem.

Writing outcomes: narrative, advertisement and poem.

Spelling: the ee sound spelt ei; words ending in -ant, -ance and -ancy; words ending in shus spelt -cious; words ending in shus spelt -tious; words ending in shul spelt -cial or -tial

Grammar and punctuation: Revisiting conventions and rules of speech punctuation when using dialogue in stories; identifying modal verbs and the verbs they are modifying and choosing modal verbs for impact.

French

- 'Weather and Transport' is the topic.

Pupils will learn the vocabulary for the weather and different items of clothing. Pupils will build written sentences and present their work on what clothing is appropriate for different types of weather. Pupils will also be introduced to different methods of transport.

Computing

- 'iAdvertise' is the topic.

Pupils will be introduced to advertising across three different mediums: Print, TV and Radio. They will learn how to create radio adverts and jingles to suit different products and themes, create a TV advert for a new product and finally a digital print advert for their product.
