



The average total points score, for your school, in all GLD goals is **23.1** out of a possible 24.






Your school's EYFSP good level of development has **increased by 5.0%** from **78.9%** in 2023/24 to **83.9%** in 2024/25.

83.9% achieved a good level of development in your school, **15.6% higher than** the National average of **68.3%**.

This is the equivalent of **5 more** pupils in your school achieving a good level of development compared to the National average.

Your school has been above the National average **3 times** in the last 3 academic year(s).

Your school's relative change for achieving a good level of development has **improved by 2.9%**, from **+1.5%** in 2023/24 to **+4.4%** in 2024/25 when compared to the National average.

While your school average for achieving a good level of development has **increased by 5.0%**, from **78.9%** in 2023/24 to **83.9%** in 2024/25, the National average **increased by 0.6%**, from **67.7%** in 2023/24 to **68.3%** in 2024/25.
