



English Writing

We will explore the books 'The Lost Happy Endings' and 'The Proudest Blue'. We will write a range of pieces such as a setting description, a poem, instructions and a short narrative.



English Reading

Krindlekraxx by Phillip Ridley

We will explore this story while exploring different aspects of reading comprehension. We will focus on skills such as summarising, clarifying, evaluating, inferring and predicting.

Science

Fossils and Soils

Pupils will describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock. They will also explore soil, the importance of soil, plan soil experiment, investigate soil experiment and evaluate experiment.

Mathematics

Multiplication and Division, Length and Perimeter

In Multiplication and Division, pupils will recap prior learning with multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and will then learn the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. In Length and Perimeter, pupils will explore measuring, equivalent lengths and comparing lengths.

Music

Ensemble Skills: Call & Response

Year 3 marks the beginning of students' development of ensemble skills. Pupils will learn to actively listen, response, and cooperate with peers in a musical context.

Geography

Rivers

Children will learn about what a river is and explore rivers across the world, including those in Europe, Africa, Asia, Australia, South America and North America.

History

The Anglo Saxons, Scots and Vikings

We will explore: Anglo Saxon England, The Scots and the Picts, settlements, culture, religion, Viking Raids and Invasion

French

Musical Instruments

We will learn the basics of the French language including how to name instruments.

Art of Ancient Egypt

Having learned about the Ancient Egyptians in History, we will look in more details at The Great Sphinx, The Bust of Nefertiti, papyrus and Ancient Egyptian Gods

Sequencing Sounds

Pupils will learn programming sequencing in Scratch, building from basic concepts to create a final project representing a flute.
