

<p>Northern Ireland We will learn about Northern Ireland, including its geography, history, and landmarks. Pupils will explore its division from the Republic of Ireland, visit sites like the Giant's Causeway and Marble Arch Caves, and understand the region's cultural and physical features.</p>	<p>The Rise and Fall of the Roman Empire We will learn about key events in the Roman Empire, including the Punic Wars, Rome's expansion, Julius Caesar's rise, and Caesar Augustus' reign during the Pax Romana. Pupils will also study the spread of Christianity and the causes of the empire's fall.</p>	<p>Ma famille Pupils will learn how to talk about different members of their family in French and develop conversational skills.</p>
