



English Writing

We will explore 'Cinnamon' by Neil Gaiman and 'Frindleswyld' by Natalia and Lauren O'Hara. We will write diaries, informal letters, adverts, limericks and poetic forms.



English Reading

'The Wild Robot - Peter Brown' We will develop extended answers for retrieval and inference questions, providing evidence and explanations.



Science

Sound

We will learn about vibrations and how sound is produced, as well as the structure and function of the ear. Students will investigate how volume and pitch affect sound, plan and conduct experiments to explore volume, and evaluate their findings.

Religious Education

World Faith: Hinduism— How do Hindus worship?

Why do Hindus have many images of God? Why is the Aum symbol important to Hindus? How do Hindus worship at home? How does a Hindu priest help Hindus worship at the mandir? Why do Hindus go on pilgrimage?

Mathematics

Multiplication and Division

We will explore factor pairs and practice multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100. We will multiply 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, and divide 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers. We will also solve correspondence problems and develop efficient multiplication strategies.

PSHE

What is citizenship?

We will explore citizenship, British values, and the purpose of laws, including the Equality Act, and develop debate skills by considering what laws they would create.

Geography

Eastern Europe

We will explore key places in Eastern Europe, including their climate and physical features, compare and contrast an Eastern European country, and examine historical and current conflicts.

History

Life in Ancient Rome

We will explore Ancient Rome by locating it, learning about the monarchy and republic, examining its governments, studying Pompeii, daily life, and discovering the legacy of Latin.

Music

We will be developing skills and learning how to read music, including reading notations, and understanding time. In our guitar lessons will we be developing the skills we have previously been taught.

Art

Design

We will explore: What is design in art?, examining design in Matisse's cut outs, examining design in The Scream— expressionism, examining design in The Scream—colour and making your own Scream!

Computing

Repetition in Shapes

Pupils will use Logo, a programming language, to create shapes and patterns. They will learn about repetition and loops, which are important concepts in programming.
