States of Matter

Mathematics

Multiplication and Division

Children will be learning how to estimate answers and check their strategies, find and compare areas, multiply and divide by numbers like 3, 6, 7, 9, 11, and 12, and even practice multiplying three numbers together.

Music

Guitars: Basic Skills

Children will be learning how to hold the guitar in rest and ready positions, how to place their fingers for playing, learn the notes on open strings, play a simple tune, and understand rhythm by reading musical notation. They will build upon their knowledge from last term.

Geography

Mediterranean Europe

Children will explore key locations across Europe, learn about the warm Mediterranean climate, discover the region's food and farming practices, study its landscapes, and understand how people have settled in these areas.

History

Ancient Greece

Children will be learning how the Ancient Greeks built important buildings with large columns, how their Olympic Games included sports like running, javelin, and horse events, and how the Ancient Greeks left a lasting legacy that is still remembered today.
