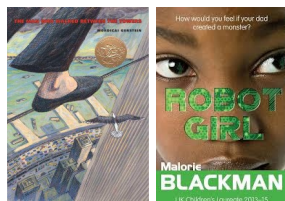




English Writing

We will write letters, persuasive speeches, interviews and autobiographies.



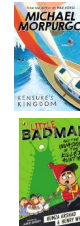
English Reading

Space

We will explore the Solar System (including ideas over time), the planets, motion of the Earth, the Moon, night and day.

Religious Education

Christianity: How do art and music convey Christmas?

Week 1: What do the Gospel accounts reveal about the theology (beliefs) associated with the festival of Christmas?

Week 2: How is the theology (beliefs) of Christmas represented in art today?

Week 3: Do carols convey the beliefs of Christmas to the world?

Week 4: The Nativity narrative - whose story is it to tell?

Mathematics

Multiplication and Division

Multiples, Common multiples, Factors, Common factors, Prime numbers, Square numbers, Cube numbers, Multiply by 10, 100 and 1,000

Fractions

Equivalent fractions, finding fractions equal to unit and non-unit fractions, convert between improper fractions and mixed numbers, compare and order fractions less than and greater than one.

Music

Developing Sight Reading Skills 1: Melodies (Glockenspiel)

Students work on developing their sight-reading skills, specifically for melodies on the glockenspiel. We will build upon the ability to read and play melodies fluently, preparing us for more advanced sight-reading challenges and ensemble playing in future units.

Geography

Mountains

We will explore the Alps, the high peaks of the Himalayas, American mountains and African mountains.

History

The Early British Empire

We will learn about the British Empire, global trade, the Mughal Empire and the East India Company, the Seven Years War and what motivated Britain to build an empire.

Music (Violin)

We will be learning two pieces: "Manhattan Taxi" and "Latin Mystery." We will be introduced to the quavers (half beat notes) and quaver rests, while also beginning to explore the bow, including the parts of the bow and a proper bow hold.
