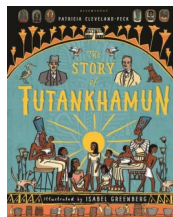




English Writing

We will explore the books 'The Story of Tutankhamun' and 'The Last Garden'. Pupils will write in different styles including writing a non-chronological report, writing in role, creating a warning poster, writing dialogue and writing a narrative.



English Reading

We will be reading **Ariki and the Island of Wonders** by Nico-la Davies and **The Day I Was Erased** by Lisa Thompson. Through these engaging stories, pupils will develop key reading comprehension skills such as making inferences, clarifying meaning, and exploring characters' thoughts and feelings.

Science

We will explore:
Nutrition and diet: food groups, balanced diets, understand the five food groups, compare diets and animal diets.
Rocks: Identify rocks, group rocks, test rocks and local rock survey.

Mathematics

Addition and Subtraction & Multiplication and Division

In Addition and Subtraction, pupils will explore how to add and subtract numbers with no exchanges and with exchanges, as well as how to estimate answers. In Multiplication and Division, pupils will recap prior learning with multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and will then learn the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

Music

Exploring Staff Notation 1

Year 3 will venture into the world of staff notation, with a particular focus on pitch, using the glockenspiel. Pupils learn to further differentiate between high and low pitches and start reading simple melodies.

Settlements

We will explore: Types of Settlements, Urban, Rural and Sub-urban Areas, Population Density, What do Settlements Need?

History

Ancient Egypt

We will explore: Locating Egypt and the Nile, Life in Ancient Egypt, Religion and the Afterlife, Tutankhamun and Howard Carter, Hieroglyphics

French

Animals

In this French unit, children will be learning the names of different animals and exploring how to describe them using simple French vocabulary.

Still Life and Form

We will explore: Creating form with tone, Drawing a still life using cross-hatching, A study of Cezanne, Still life using colour
